

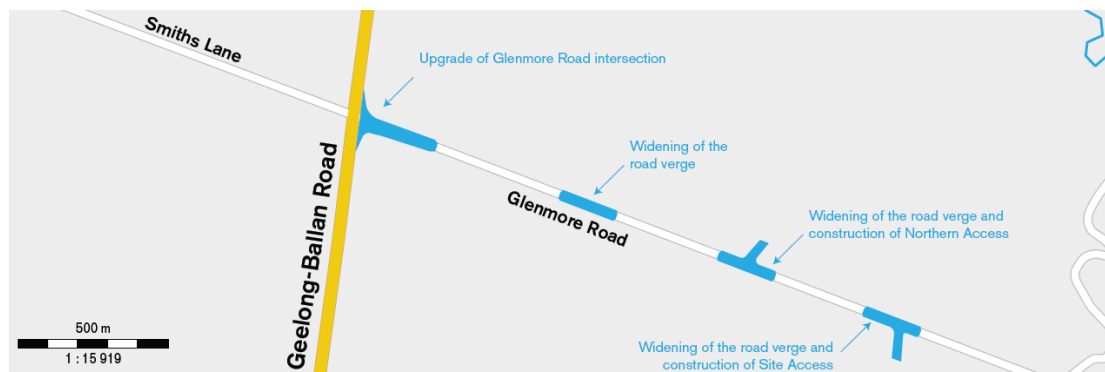

### Yaloak South Wind Farm - Commencement of Construction

Following the recent pop-up information session held at Mount Wallace Jubilee Hall, Pacific Hydro is delighted to announce that work on road upgrades will commence next week, from Monday 26 September 2016. In the event of inclement weather, the works may be delayed but will commence as soon as possible thereafter.

As part of the Yaloak South Wind Farm Project, sections of Glenmore Road will be upgraded between the Geelong-Ballan Road intersection and the site entrance, approximately 2km to the east.




#### Overview of road upgrade works
