
Yaloak South Wind Farm – Update

Dear Neighbour,

Please find an update from the Yaloak South Wind Farm Project below.

Construction Progress

14 concrete foundations are now complete using concrete and quarry products from local suppliers. Each foundation used over 750 tons of concrete which saw an increased amount of truck traffic on local roads on construction days. Thank you for your patience during these important works.

Construction of the powerline between the wind farm and Hamills Lane is underway. Powercor have installed most of the poles and have begun to install the powerlines. When these are being installed above the road, traffic conditions on Glenmore Road may temporarily change with a lowered speed limit and traffic control staff present. These powerline works should be finished by late July.

Other works in July and August include minor earthworks and concreting across the wind farm site. This work is much smaller than the foundation pours and will need less truck movements to complete. As the earthworks are completed, our project partners WRJV will begin to reduce their presence on site. There may be some truck movements along Glenmore Road and Geelong-Ballan Road as bulldozers and earthmoving equipment are taken away.

Funding now available for Yaloak South community initiatives

The Yaloak South Community Fund has been established to share the benefits of Pacific Hydro's Yaloak South Wind Farm with the community. \$28,000 will be available each year over the 25-year life of the project.

Do you have a great project or idea that would benefit your community? Expressions of interest are now invited from community groups or individuals, and priority will be placed on projects that serve the areas of Beremboke, Mount Wallace, and Rowsley.

Visual Screening Program

Pacific Hydro is offering a visual screening program for residential properties located close to the Yaloak South Wind Farm Project.
