Crowlands Wind Farm Project - Update

Dear Neighbour,

Please find an update from the Crowlands Wind Farm Project below.

Works on Spring Flat Road

To enable vehicles to access the project site during construction, Spring Flat Road will be receiving a range of upgrades over the next few weeks.


These upgrades will enable components and equipment to be brought to the site by road, including oversize loads such as earthmoving equipment, wind turbine components and blades, and electrical transformers.

The works will include:

- Permanent straightening of some sections of the road
- Temporary widening of the road at some curves
- Construction of passing areas and holding bays
- Installation of drainage culverts and signage
- Tree trimming and vegetation management along the roadway
- Construction of a new road crossing over the Spring Creek waterway (concrete causeway)

These works will commence shortly and continue for the next few weeks (except the period 22 December 2017 – 4 January 2018).

As a part of these works, a closure of the very northern end of Spring Flat Road is planned for Wednesday 20 and Thursday 21 December.





While these works are being carried out you may experience short delays. Further short-term road closures may also be required but we will endeavour to provide notice of these works to the community in advance. Traffic management will be in place for the duration of the works, with speed restrictions and temporary warning signage.

Other Works in December

Upcoming works on the project include cultural heritage survey works, onsite surveying and the installation of fencing to protect ecologically and culturally sensitive areas. For more information about the project and regular construction updates please visit our website.

Visual Screening Program

Pacific Hydro is offering a visual screening program for residential properties located close to the Crowlands Wind Farm Project.

Visual screening helps to reduce potential visual impacts with the use of landscaping, tree planting, and other treatments on our project neighbours' land.

These works are arranged with costs covered by Pacific Hydro; including maintenance and watering for a period of two years after planting.
