## Invitation to our neighbours

### An invitation to meet with us

Project representatives will be in Keyneton on Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 June 2018 to meet individually with residents living within a 3km radius of the wind farm (refer to map overleaf). The purpose of these meetings is to enable Pacific Hydro to hear from its neighbours to understand each resident's specific situation in relation to the wind farm and address any questions.

Pacific Hydro is developing a wind farm in Keyneton, South Australia. The site is located 6km west of Sedan and 10km south east of Angaston and runs approximately 15km along the Mount Lofty Ranges.

Following extensive consultation between 2009-2012, the project was approved by the South Australian Development Assessment Commission on 6 December 2013.

Recognising that some time has passed since the project was granted approval and new residents may have moved into the area, Pacific Hydro would like to reconnect with its neighbours as it prepares for the secondary consent phase of the wind farm development ahead of construction.

### Upcoming community information session

While the initial meetings are to understand individual circumstances for those living closest to the wind farm, Pacific Hydro is committed to engaging with all of its stakeholders

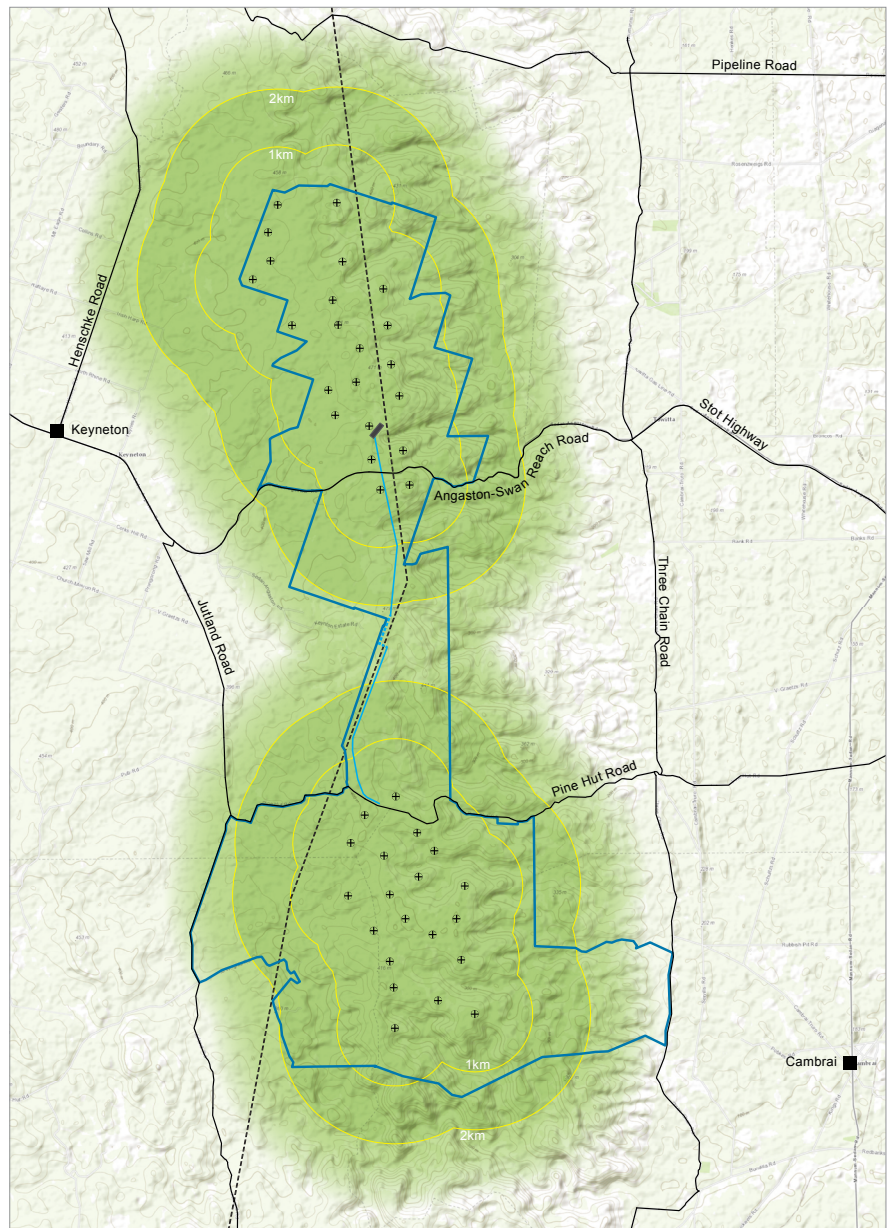
